**The English language version of the State and Contribution Regulations is to be considered informative.
Solely the German version is to be considered legally binding.**

1 Principle

These Rules of Contribution are not part of the Statutes. However, they regulate the contribution obligations of the members as well as the fees and contributions. Therefore, it can only be amended by the General Assembly of the Sustainable Aviation Initiative (SAI).

2 Resolutions

The general assembly decides on the contents of the contribution rules with a simple majority. The fixed amounts shall be levied on January 1 of the following year in which the resolution was passed. By resolution of the general assembly, another date can also be set.

3 Contributions

The amount of the contributions are shown in the table below:

3.1 Contributions	
Member	Contribution amount per year
Natural person	50 € or free choice of contribution (> 50 €)
A natural person reduced (pupils, students, trainees, up to the age of 27, trainees, FSJ)	20 €
Natural person (minor < 18)	0 €
Supporting member	120 € or free choice of contribution (> 120 €)
Legal entity/company	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 - 25 employees: 500€ • 26 - 250 employees: 1000€ • 251 - 550 employees: 2000€ • 551 - 2500 employees: 3000€ • 2501 - 5000 employees: 4000€ • > 5000 employees: On request
Proof of donation	A receipt will be issued for each donation made

It is possible at any time for every future or already an active member to apply for a reduction of the membership fee by giving justified reasons. The board decides this with a simple majority. Likewise, the contribution of legal entities can be reduced or increased in individual cases with the approval of the majority of the board.

4 Maturity

Dues shall be levied annually and shall be payable in advance by January 31. Members joining in the financial year shall pay the monthly pro-rata annual subscription, including the month of joining, in advance. The contribution will be retained in full upon resignation.

5 Form of payment

It is preferred that the contribution is paid by direct debit. In addition, there is the possibility of transferring the due contribution.

6 Arrears of contributions

A member can be excluded from the association if the contribution is not paid. This happens if the member is in arrears with his subscription payment during his membership despite two reminders of more than six months each. Or if, despite a reminder, payment has not been received within 12 months. In this case, the member is to be requested in writing, also in electronic form, to pay his membership fee within four weeks after the expiry of the deadline (cf. §6.2 of the statutes). In case of non-payment, the deletion from the membership list becomes effective automatically. Furthermore, if the member concerned has failed to notify the association of a new address or a new e-mail address, the deletion shall also be effective without notification.

8 Cancellation

There is a notice period of one month to the end of the year (§5.2 of the statutes). In case of a member's resignation, termination or exclusion, the membership fee paid for the current business year will be retained.

9 Changes

The General Assembly shall decide amendments to the contribution regulations by a simple majority.

10 Entry into force

The contribution rules are valid from the day of the decision by the general assembly. The contribution rules are valid until the general assembly passes an amendment.
